Executive Description

The Above Water Warfare Capability Group (AWW CG) and the Underwater Warfare Capability Group (UWW CG) are entities subordinate to the NATO Naval Armaments Group, responsible for promoting cooperation and standardisation in the Above- and Under Water Warfare domain. In particular, the emphasis is to identify solutions for NATO capability shortfalls, to promote multinational activities, to network with communities of interest, and to support the NATO Defence Planning Process.

The Capability Groups are established on an indefinite entitled basis. They are the main fora for coordinating events, planning information exchange and promoting discussions regarding their respective capability topics in NATO. They are responsible for the fulfilment of the tasks assigned by their Main Armaments Groups and for directing the work of their subordinate bodies in accordance with their respective Terms of Reference.
